



- 1. The programme is approved by AICTE.
- 2. The programme will enable students to acquire dual specializations.
- 3. The programme will have great emphasis and focus on the use of Big Data and Artificial Intelligence for making managerial decisions.
- 4. Apart from traditional specializations in Human Resource Management, Marketing Management, Finance Management and Operations Management, the programme will allow students to take up new areas of specialization.
- 5. The student can acquire specialization in functional areas of management as well as in sectoral areas of Energy Management, Urban Infrastructure Management, Health Systems Management.
- 6. The programme will be delivered by the best teachers and trainers of ASCI who have shaped top management executives in many corporations.
- 7. The programme aims to provide global exposure to students.
- 8. The programme is designed for preparing managers for high growth sectors of the economy.
- 9. Eligibility will be graduates in any discipline with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks and a valid score from any of the management entrance exams approved by AICTE, viz, CAT/XAT/MAT/ATMA/CMAT/GMAT and any other qualifying exam(as per AICTE).

Course Highlights: The course is spread over four semesters. It is a unique blend of classroom teaching, practical training and experiential exercises, field visits, extensive industry interface in the form of guest lectures, conferences, and course modules taught by industry experts. The first year, spanning two semesters aims to cultivate multidisciplinary skills, communications skills, and core management disciplines.

Course Curriculum

The curriculum consists of compulsory courses as well as electives. In the entire 2-year programme, the students will have to take 33 courses. Of these, 29 courses are compulsory, and 4 are electives.

Dual Specialization: Each student can choose a dual specialization. The specialization subjects may be from functional areas of management or in sectoral areas.

Internship and Dissertation: Each student will have to undergo an internship with an organization at the end of the 2nd semester for three months. Also, they will also have to conduct a dissertation at the end of the 4th semester.

Venue and Facilities

Programme Venue: The programme will be conducted in the College Park Campus located in Banjara Hills, in the heart of the city.

Learning Aids: The campus has full-fledged, well-equipped air conditioned conference / Lecture rooms accompanied with facilities like computers, Internet, Audio-Visual facilities and Office- Automation aids, etc.

Computer based Business Simulation Lab: Well equipped 30 high-end terminals for conducting business simulation and analytics lab using the latest software tools.

Auditorium: The campus has a large auditorium that hosts various events like Guest Lectures, Academic Conventions, Cultural Programmes and Annual Convocations. It has a seating capacity of three hundred participants and state-of-the-art Audio-Visual facilities.

Residential Facilities: The campus is equipped with comfortable and safe boarding facilities for students. The non a/c double occupancy rooms are well suited for student life.

In-Campus Boarding Facilities: The campus has full-fledged dining facilities. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner are served for residents at specified hours. Vegetarian and Non-vegetarian dishes are served.

Wi-Fi Enabled Campus: The campus has a good computer network and dedicated High-Speed Internet connectivity and it is fully Wi-Fi enabled.

Digital Library: ASCI has one of the finest libraries with a rich collection of books, journals, and Audio-Visual resources on various aspects of functional, sectoral, and general management.

It is a hybrid library with over 80,000 books and other Knowledge Resources, newspapers, dictionaries, reference books, audio-visual materials, and electronic resources such as e-journals and databases. It also offers services such as reference service, research support, circulation, document delivery, databases training support, user, bibliographic service, online catalogue, selective dissemination of information, current awareness service by providing new arrivals of books.

Outbound Learning: The classroom sessions are complemented and supplemented by exposure visits that ASCI organizes for the students. Exposure visits to various organisations enable students to understand and appreciate, the concepts they have been exposed to and gain a hands on experience of the organizational challenges and situations typical of real-life scenarios.

Extracurricular Activities: ASCI organises various curricular and extracurricular events such as conferences, workshops, competitions, management festivals, cultural programmes, get-togethers as well as sporting events for the students.

Sports and Games: A gamut of sports and games activities are available for students like swimming, billiards, chess, tennis, table tennis, badminton, carroms, croquet, etc. Students are encouraged to use the on-campus gym facilities.

Placement Assistance: The Programme has a dedicated Placement Cell with qualified and experienced professionals. 





Selection shall be based on a combination of factors, including academic credentials, scores in the qualifying examination. Personal Interview and a demonstrated interest in the management field.


