# A FLIP THROUGH ITS GOLDEN PAGES

auhati University, the oldest and largest University in the North East India, was established in the year 1948. The University came to existence through the Gauhati University Act, 1947 passed by the State Legislature of Assam on 15 October, 1947. It is the product of the collective dream of visionaries like Gopinath Bardoloi, Krishna Kanta Handique who prudently visualised the importance of institutes of higher education in the region. It was also the untiring efforts of Fakaruddin Ali Ahmed, Madhab Chandra Bezbaruah, Dr. Bhubaneswar Barua and others that contributed significantly to the establishment of Gauhati University.

The University started functioning from Cotton College and was shifted to the present campus in 1955–56. It had 18 affiliated colleges and eight Post Graduate Departments at the time of its establishment. At present there are more than 350 affiliated colleges offering undergraduate and post graduate courses in total of 7 Faculties – Arts, Science, Commerce & Management, Law, Medicine & Allied Health Sciences, Engineering and Technology. The University has forty-two Post Graduate Departments, an Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL), an Institute of Science and Technology and a constituent Law College in the main campus.

The University campus is situated at the western fringe of Guwahati, about 15 kilometers from the city centre with the mighty Brahmaputra to the North. It has a sprawling, scenic and serene campus and is entirely self-contained, with Markets, a hospital, Banks, a Post office, sports facilities etc. The University has an impressive academic infrastructure including well-equipped laboratories, one central and departmental libraries and computer facilities, a Botanical Garden, a Bio Diversity Park, an Observatory etc. The K.K. Handique Central Library has been recognized as a Manuscript resource and a conservation centre by the Government of India. The University has capacity building centres such as the Career Counseling and Guidance Centre, the Pre-Examination Training Centre and the Women's Studies Research Centre that contribute to the overall development of the students.

The University has introduced choice-based credit system which is a student-friendly system where students get the opportunity of opting for courses according to their interests and needs. The system gives the students a competitive edge in the national and global Market. A ten-point grading scale is in place to standardize evaluation with respect to international benchmarks.

# ADMISSION PROCEDURE

# APPLICATION FORM FOR ADMISSION

Online application form will be live on the admission portal of Gauhati University on 5 August 2020 The admission process will be fully on-line, including payment of application fee.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

(A) B.A/B.Sc./B.Com. (in 10+2+3 pattern) with Major/honours courses in the concerned subject or B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (in 10+2+3 pattern) with a general pass course with at least 45% Marks in the concerned subject as well as in aggregate or equivalent CGPA. [45% Marks is to be calculated on the basis of marks obtained in Part I and Part II of the (2+1) pattern and part I, part II and Part III of the (1+1+1) pattern are eligible to seek admission to the University. However, certain specific eligibility criteria have been fixed by the concerned departments and these are applicable especially for the interdisciplinary subjects.

- **(B)** The admissions will be conducted on the basis of merit in the Qualifying Examination based on G.U Rules.
- **(C)** An applicant who has completed a Postgraduate Course from GU on an earlier occasion or got admitted into a Postgraduate Course of GU, whether completed or not, will be considered for fresh admission irrespective of whatever quota he/she claims, if any, only when all fresh candidates including those from Wait List and all statutory quotas, including other quota like EC, NCC, Fringe Village etc. are admitted and seats remain vacant. Alternatively, he/she is not entitled to admission until the fresh applicants (first timers)

are completely admitted subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria. However, these rules may be relaxed in case of professional courses coming under the purview of regulatory bodies like AICTE, NCTE, BCI, (courses like MBA, M.Tech, LLM, etc.).

- Scheduled Caste: 7%
- Scheduled Tribes (Plains): 10%
- Scheduled Tribes (Hill): 5%
- OBC & MOBC: 15%
- Differently Abled: 3% (for each Discipline of Faculty)
- Sons and daughters of permanent GU Employees: 1 Seat in each dept with intake capacity 40 or less and 2 seats when the intake is more than 40 students.
- Fringe Village: 10 seats
- GU Ex-Employees: 5 seats
- Ex- Defense: As per EC resolution
- Moran Community of Assam: 2 seats.
- Extra Curricular: 1 seat in each department.
- NCC & NSS: 5 seats.
- Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% Reservation from unreserved category in each subject.

# UNIVERSITY-WISE SEAT MATRIX

- 80% seats in traditional programmes of study are exclusively reserved for GU students and remaining 20% seats for others.
- All interdisciplinary seats are open to all students irrespective of any university.

SUBMISSION OF EC, FV, DA, GU EMP. ETC. QUOTA FORMS (A) Those seeking admission under any reservations/quota (viz. Differently abled/disabled, sons and daughters of permanent GU employees in service, fringe village and extra-curricular & co-curricular activities, etc.), Will have to submit additional prescribed forms separately in the Office of the Secretary University Classes, GU.

(B) One seat in each subject may be offered for admission to M.A./M.Sc. /M. Com courses to students who have shown extraordinary proficiency in the last three years preceding graduation. Events of sports

Extra- curricular activities in the last three years preceding graduation. Events of sports and other EC activities will be those incorporated in the inter University sports / Cultural / Literary Competition. Any sports event organized by an association must be recognized by and affiliated to the national body for that sport/event and by Indian Olympic Association.

(c) Any student having more than five years of gap period is not eligible for admission.

Preference will be given to candidates in the following order:

- 1. Those who represented the country in International events.
- 2. Those who won prizes at recognised National level events.
- 3. Those who won prizes in the Inter-University sports/Cultural/Literary events.
- 4. Those who represented Gauhati University in the Inter-University Sports/Cultural/Literary meet or the State at National events.
- 5. Those who won prizes in the Inter-College Youth Festival, G.U. and Inter-College Sports Meet, under G.U. Sports Board.
- 6. Those who won prizes at recognised State level competitions.
- 7. Students who were awarded fellowships/ scholarships by Central Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Youth Welfare for excellence in art, culture & sports etc.

CRITERIA FOR RESERVATION UNDER NCC & NSS QUOTA

- 1. Those who have obtained NCC 'C' Certificate or have participated in the Republic Day Parade under NCC.
- 2. Those who have obtained NCC 'B' Certificate or have participated in the Republic Day Parade under NCC. (This is applicable only for the students applying for admission into integrated courses).
- 3. Those who represented the University in NSS Camp at National Level. These certificates need to be obtained in the last three years

preceding admission.

# STUDENTS

Gauhati University has separate guidelines regarding admission of International Students to Graduate and Masters Programs. Academic qualifications from Universities or Boards of Higher Education, recognized as equivalent by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) shall be the sole criterion for admission under these regulations into the various academic programs/courses in the University Departments/Centres for the International/NRI students. By 'International student' is meant one who has a valid passport of the home country at the time of application. Students from the negative list of countries of MHRD, Govt. of India will not be admitted. International Students can seek admission to various Graduate and Masters Programs under the following categories:

- ☐ Self-financing students (Full programme)
- □ Cultural Exchange Fellowship Programmes (Govt. of India): International students with ICSSR fellowship (Government of India) desirous of admission under this Fellowship Programmes are required to apply through the Indian High Commission/ Embassy as the case may be, in their respective countries. Such students need to send the application to ICSSR, Government of India. ICSSR will forward the application/s to various Universities/Institutes in India as the case may be for consideration. In case the applicant is found suitable for admission offer letter will be sent to him/her through Indian Council for Cultural Relations, New Delhi.
- ☐ Visiting Students under Memorandum of Understanding (MoU): Admission of International students/NRI Students under MoUs will be made in accordance with the terms and conditions spelt out in the MoUs agreed to between Gauhati University and the Country/University/Institution concerned.

# ANTI RAGGING

Your wards are in safe hands. In order to Make the students feel at home and to curb the menace of ragging, the University has a very structured Anti-Ragging Committee and squads. Each student now MUST file an ONLINE Anti-Ragging Affidavit as per the directive received from the UGC. This process DOES NOT involve any money, any signature form Notary Public / Oath Commissioner etc, or any need to scan any documents. This process involves the following steps:

- 1. Logon to www.antiragging.in
- 2. Fill in the desired information
- 3. On succesful completion, you will receive the Affidavits, both for parents and students through Email
- 4. Sign them and submit to respective departments.

# GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

The University is committed to taking up the grievances of its stakeholders. The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) addresses complaints of grievances received and responds to these at the earliest.

# GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES

- 1. No student shall be admitted to any programme of study, if he/she is found to have indulged in activities detrimental to academic interests.
- 2. No student shall be admitted to more than one course in the same shift.
- 3. A student who is found to violate the University rules shall be liable for expulsion.
- 4. If a student's involvement in any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authorities, such a student would be given an opportunity to explain, and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, that student will be expelled from the university.
- 5. A student who is found to have indulged in consumption of drugs or intoxicating drinks, gambling and other unsocial activities shall be liable to expulsion.
- 6. Students admitted to various courses of studies are required to participate in instructions (lectures, tutorials, seminars, laboratory work and other academic activities) as prescribed in the relevant
  - Regulations and shall be expected to participate in the Co-Curricular and Extra Curricular activities organised by department or by the university. They are expected to appear in the examination due at the end of the course of studies. Students who fail to do so without assigning sufficient reasons to the satisfaction of the competent authority shall not be permitted to continue their studies in the following year.
- 7. Attendance in Classes is compulsory. To be eligible to sit for the examinations as a regular candidate, the student should have at least 75% of attendance of lectures (separately for the theoretical and practical classes) as prescribed in the concerned Regulations.
- 8. Each Academic session will run as per the Academic Calendar published by the University.
- 9. The admission will be granted in accordance with the provision made in the Ordinance on admission of students to P. G. Courses etc.
- 10. The students shall have to comply with the Regulations for the course, and other rules and orders as may be prescribed by the university authorities from time to time.
- 11. The decision of competent/appropriate bodies like the Residence, Health and Discipline Board and the Executive Council on all matters relating to students' indiscipline shall be final and binding.

# STEP BY STEP ADMISSION PROCESS

- > Students and parents/guardians are advised to visit the web-pages of particular departments and colleges for necessary information.
- > Keep ready all documents and information required to submit along with the Application Form.
- > Follow the instructions step by step and proceed.
- An applicant can apply to one Traditional Course and two Interdisciplinary Courses only. Please check the list of Traditional and Interdisciplinary Courses.
- The Application Form for Admission is editable, but once you finally submit, it will no longer be editable.
- You can submit the form even if your result is not declared; you will be given a duration of time (to be notified), to feed your marks obtained in the qualifying examination. After this period, the window will be closed.
- The Email ID and phone number of the students and parents/guardians may be used for further communication.
- ➤ Please check the eligibility conditions before submission of the On-line Application Form.
- > The provisional merit list of students will be published in the University website only.
- Appearance of your name in the provisional merit list is not a guarantee of your admission. It depends on fulfillment of eligibility conditions and intake of the department/colleges for the concerned Course.
- All are advised to keep visiting the website for any update regarding the Admission process from time to time.
- ➤ The University is not responsible for any unwanted technical failure which may disturb the admission process, either at the University end, or from the student's end.
