# BBA-LLB (Hons.) Program

**Eligibility:** Pass in Class XII or equivalent with an aggregate of 50% and above marks (any discipline) in English medium. Class XII (or equivalent) students who appeared for thier final examinations before August 01,2017 and awaiting results are also eligible to apply.

# LLM Programs

## The Center of Postgraduate Legal Studies

The ICFAI Law School has launched the 'Centre of Postgraduate Legal Studies' with an objective of offering one year full time LLM programs in Law to facilitate the students of LLM to continue their education and research in the same campus.

The Center of Postgraduate Legal Studies, offers one year LLM Programs in semester mode in accordance with the guidelines of UGC. The program helps in enhancing the knowledge base of the students in academics, professional understanding and readiness to face the challenges of the corporate world.

## LLM in Corporate and Commercial Laws

The program is a blend of theoretical and practical learning, provides wider horizons of corporate and commercial laws. Students joining the program shall have the unique experience of innovative teaching methods comparable to that of best academic institutions of the country.

## LLM in Tax Laws

This is a practice oriented program which provides inputs in the area of taxation. The students joining the program shall have a comprehensive understanding of litigation procedures, relating to taxation.

### Eligibility:

- Graduation in Five Year / Three Year / Integrated Law Programs or equivalent Degree recognized by The Bar Council of India with a minimum of 50% Marks or equivalent Grade.
- Should have qualified in the ILSAT (PG) 2017 conducted by ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad.
- The students appearing for final year examinations and awaiting results may also apply for the Entrance Examination.



### Program Structure:

- Core and elective courses
- Credit and non-credit courses
- Project / Dissertation.

The program structure includes: Three Foundation/ compulsory courses of three credits each; Six optional / specialization courses of two credits each; Dissertation of three credits. An option of choosing one non-credit course in the third trimester.

# Ph.D. Program

## (Full-time & Part-time)

The ICFAI Law School offers both full time and part time research program (Ph.D) in Law.

**Full Time Ph.D. Program:** Candidates registered for full time research shall work and conduct research on a full time basis under a recognized research supervisor. The duration of Ph.D. course for a full time research scholar is four (4) years from the date of admission. Full time Ph.D. scholars will be provided with hostel accommodation as per the terms of the University.

**Part Time Ph.D. Program:** Candidates registered as part time research scholars shall work and conduct research for four (4) years under a recognized supervisor. Candidates seeking admission as part time research scholars have to submit no objection certificate from the employer to pursue Ph.D. Course and also during summer term for attending classes of Ph.D. course work conducted in two spells in the first two years of the program.

### Eligibility

- A candidate is eligible for admission into Ph.D. program both full time/part time if he/she obtained not less than 55% marks at the Post Graduate Degree in Law in regular study mode from a recognized University.

The following candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria are eligible for admission into part time Ph.D. Program:

- Regular teachers working in University Law Colleges or affiliated Law Colleges with a minimum of three years continuous teaching experience.
- Practicing Advocates with a minimum of 5 years professional experience.
- Judicial Officers with a minimum of 5 years experience. Retired Judicial Officers are also eligible to pursue Ph.D. Program in Law.
- Any Gazetted Officer with a minimum of 8 years of administrative experience.
- Any Executive with a minimum of 10 years of administrative experience in any recognized Law Firm/Tax Consultants/ Public or Private Limited Company/ Company Secretaries/ LLP.

### Ph.D. Eligibility Test

Admission into Ph.D. full time/ part time program in Law shall be through an Ph.D. eligibility test followed

by Ph.D. admission interview. All the candidates who satisfy the eligibility criteria shall appear for the Ph.D. eligibility test. The candidates who are qualified in UGC/ JRF examination/NET/SLET are exempted from appearing Ph.D. eligibility test.

### Pattern of Ph.D. Eligibility Test

The eligibility test is of objective type with multiple choice questions covering the subjects of Constitutional Law, Indian Penal Code, Law of Torts, Corporate Law, Labour Law and Jurisprudence. Syllabus for eligibility test on the above subjects will be given along with the application form. Duration of the test is of 2 hours. The minimum marks for qualifying the Ph.D. eligibility test shall be 50%.

### Ph.D. Admission Interview

Candidates who have qualified in the Ph.D. eligibility test shall be called for Ph.D. Admission Interview. After the Ph.D. Admission Interview the list of eligible candidates for registration for full time and part time Ph.D. program will be finalized.

### Research Fellowships

Limited University sponsored research fellowships are available for full time research scholars which will be awarded on the basis of merit.

## Choice Based Credit System

Teaching at ICFAI Law School is the student centric and flexible, with a focus on what is needed for student. Thus, the legal education at the ICFAI Law School, Hyderabad is broad-based and at par with global standards. 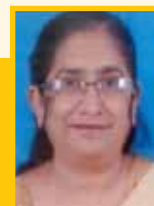

## Library

The University and ICFAI Law School has well established library. “N J Yasaswy Memorial Library”, with a built-up area of 50,000 sft equipped with latest software packages and a large collection of books, CDs, videos, Indian and International journals, magazines and research reports relating to management, law, engineering and allied subjects.

The ICFAI Law School has a separate law library in addition to the University general library. It has print collections, online resources, physical and electronic journals and books. It contains reference books, text books and general books, the Central Manuals, Law Commission Reports, Draft Bills, Case Digests, All India Reports, etc.

The library has a good collection of law journals such as Arbitration Law Report, Company Law Journal, Tax Law Journal and access to various national and international journals through net resources.

The library also has wi-fi connectivity and computing facilities for the use of faculty and students.

## Online Database

ICFAI Law School is subscribing for Manupatra, which provides access to Judgements of Supreme Court, High Court and Other Courts, International Database, Bare Acts, Text Books, Articles in Journals, Reports of various committees and other information relating to legal education.

ICFAI Law School also subscribes West Law India, an Online Legal Database which covers 1200+ journals from all over the world. This is highly useful to the faculty and students for all international law related courses.

## Computing Facilities

The campus provides the latest hardware and software infrastructure including high speed internet to cater to all the computing needs of the students. Students and faculty members has access to various databases through wi-fi connectivity. The campus is equipped with the latest state-of-the-art technology of computer net zone with high speed backbone (180 mbps internet speed) and security through CISCO high-end routers.



# Merit Scholarships

The ICFAI Law School, IFHE offers Merit Scholarships based on the percentage of marks in Class XII or equivalent and semester-wise performance.

**A. Merit Scholarships based on past academic record:** Percentage achieved in qualifying examination (Class XII or its equivalent). Scholarship will continue semester after semester only on maintaining the minimum 6.0 GPA in the previous semester. The details are presented in the following table.

These scholarships can be claimed in addition to the scholarships based on the past academic record.

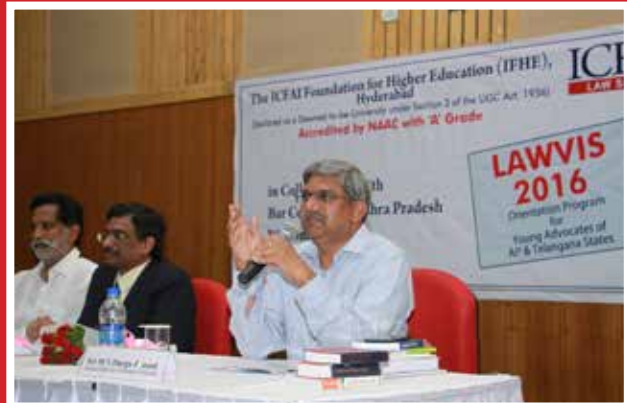
