Criteria to choose Compulsory Language Courses

Those who have studied and passed English up to class XII will befurther placed in different papers of A, B and C Categories as given below:

From 80 to 100 % marks English-A (English Language through literature)

From 60 to 79 % marks English-B (English Fluency)

From 59 to 40 % marks English-C (English Proficiency)

English B (English Fluency)

Those who have studied English up to class X will do English-B as a Compulsory Language Course in English.

English C (English Proficiency)

Those who have studied English up to class VIII will do English-C as a Compulsory Language Course in English.

Hindi A

Those who have studied Hindi up to class XII will do Hindi-A as a Compulsory Language Course in Hindi

Hindi B

Those who have studied and passed Hindi up to class X/VIII will do Hindi-B as a Compulsory Language Course in Hindi

Sanskrit

Those who have studied Sanskrit till class VIII can opt for Sanskrit as a Compulsory Language Course in lieu of Compulsory Language Course in Hindi

In Lieu

Students who have not studied Hindi till class VIII can opt for either History or Philosophy in lieu of Hindi (on the submission of valid class VIII mark sheet /Certificate from the School).

Those who opt for **History in lieu of Hindi** can take the following combinations only: Economics and Political Science

English D and Political Science

English D and Psychology

Those who opt for **Philosophy in lieu of Hindi** can take the following combinations only:

English D and History

English D and Political Science

English D and Psychology
