About us

The College

This University College of Law is the oldest College in the state running since 1946. At the initial stage, LL.B. courses were started. Later on in the year 1970, P.G. Diploma in Labour Laws, Labour Welfare and Personnel Management (DLL) was initiated. In 1971, P.G. Course-LL.M. was started. In the year 1979-80, PG Diploma in Company Law & Secretarial Practice was started and from 1995, P.G. Diploma in Criminology and Socio-Economic Crimes was started. Since then the College is at the developing state and the B.A.LL.B five years Integrated programme was started in July 2006. (1) LL.M.M.B.A. (three year integrated Programme). was started in July 2008.



The University

Mohanlal Sukhadia University is Multi-faculty Affiliating University established under UGC Act. The University consists of four Constituent Colleges and Affiliated Colleges in the Districts of Udaipur, Chittorgarh, Rajsamand, Banswara Dungarpur and Sirohi.

The erstwhile Udaipur University was established in the tribal areas of Southern Rajasthan with its headquarter at Udaipur.

This Agriculture University was turned into a Multi-Faculty University in 1964 named as University of Udaipur. As a mark of respect in the memory of Late Shri Mohanlal Sukhadia, the architect of modern Rajasthan, the university was renamed as Mohanlal Sukhadia University in 1984.

About the Programme

The Degree

B.A. LL.B. Five Years Integrated Programme is a self finance programme running under the aegis of the University College of Law under the supervision of the Programme Co ordinator & Addl. Co ordinator.

The Degree awarded will be B.A. LL.B. Five Years Integrated programme and this degree shall be conferred on graduates who have pursued a course of study as prescribed by this University spread over Five years and have passed the examinations prescribed under the relevant rules.

Duration

The course duration is full time Five Years comprising of Ten Semesters (Two Semesters per year).

Eligibility

A candidate seeking admission to this Programme shall have passed Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent in any discipline with at least 50 % of the marks from a recognized Board/Institute. SC/ST/OBC candidates who have secured 45 % of marks in aggregate are eligible.

Candidates who have appeared for the Senior Secondary examination may also appear at the entrance test, provided they submit their mark sheet before finalization of the admission.

Age 20 years for general & 22 year for SC/ST/OBC Candidates as on 1st July 2010.

Seats

Total Number of Seats are **60**

- Open Seats **50** through Entrance Test
 - Payment Seats **10** without Entrance Test
- ◆ Admission on **50** open seats will be in order of merit of Entrance Test.
 - ◆ Admission on **10** payment seats will be in order of merit of Senior Secondary Examination without Entrance Test.

Seats remaining vacant for one category may be filled by another category, if needed.

Entrance Test will be held Admission-Centres

The Entrance Test will be held at the following Centres :

- University College of Law, University Campus, Mohanlal Sukhadia University, Udaipur.
- Social Science Block, Main Campus, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

Examination Centre once opted shall not be changed in any case.

The Written Test will be of 150 maximum marks of the duration of Two hours comprising of Five Areas of equal Weights (i.e. 30 questions of multiple choice of one mark each from each section. For each correct answer, one mark shall be awarded and for every four wrong answers, one mark shall be deducted. The areas will be (a) Legal Aptitude; (b) General Awareness & Current Affairs; (c) Mathematical Ability; (d) General English; and (e) Reasoning Ability.

Reservation

As per rules of the University.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction will be English.

Attendance

The student is required to have a minimum of 70% attendance for becoming eligible to appear in the examination.

Academic Schedule

The Academic Schedule every year is of two semesters i.e. Semester one from July 1 to December 31 and Semester Two from January 1 to June 30.

Annual Breaks

Students will get two annual breaks 15 days in December and another in June.

Teaching

Teaching shall be conducted through the lecture method, practicals and class performance during the semester session. The teaching work shall be conducted for each prescribed paper for six hours a week.

Examination System

The Examination shall be conducted through written papers, practicals, Internal Assessment, Attendance in the class and viva-voce at the end of each semester. The examination for each semester shall be arranged in the month of December and June respectively during the academic session. There will be 30 marks for Internal Assessment and 70 marks for Theory Examination. The Examinee will be required to attempt Five questions in all. Question first will be compulsory (18 marks) and will

be in two parts carrying 9 marks each part. Remaining questions will carry equal marks (13 each).

A candidate who has completed a regular course of study for the respective semester will, subject to other provisions of Act, Statutes, Regulations and Rules of the University, shall be admitted to the examination.

Promotion to next semester shall be allowed to a student who has appeared for the respective Semester examinations and has passed at least in 50% of papers getting 36% marks in each paper securing 48 % marks in the aggregate for the passed papers failing which he will not be promoted to next Semester. The candidate will be given only two chances to clear due papers of each semester.

Prospectus & Application form for Entrance Test

The Prospectus & Application form for Entrance Test for Admission can be obtained personally on payment of Rs.1000/- (which includes Entrance Test fee also) in cash or if by post Rs.1050/- from the Office of the Dean, University College of Law, Udaipur from **26th April 2009**.

Prospectus and application form can also be downloaded from our Website <http://www.mlsu.org>. While submitting form, a Demand Draft of Rs. 1050/- must be submitted. For SC/ST candidates, forms will be available on Payment of Rs. 500/- in cash & by post sending a D.D. of Rs.550/-.

The duly filled-in application form shall be submitted to the College Office by 2.00 PM of 03, June 2010 Admission cards will be available for distribution at the above examination Centres one day prior to the Entrance Test.

The Entrance Test for Admission will be held on 05, June 2009 between 11.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. Result will be published in leading News Papers of the State and will be available on the website of University.

Library & Book Bank

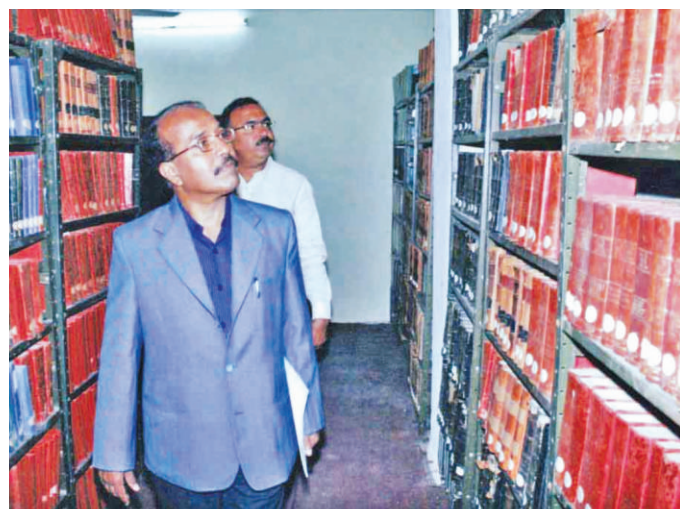
Library - The Library of University College of Law is a rich Library having 46356 number of Books, 6636 number of Journals. 31 numbers of Current Journals/ Periodicals and 18 numbers of newspapers and magazines are subscribed at present.

Book Bank - The College is running a Book Bank for the welfare of all the students of the College having a total number of 14095 Books. A Separate Book Bank is operative for SC/ST Students with the financial Assistance of Social Welfare Department of the state.



Class Room

Focus emphasis is given towards building a Foundation. Classroom inputs incorporate diverse Teaching techniques such as active discussions, role-plays, Speeches, ad-lib presentations by overhead projectors & L.C.D. etc. that provide a practical orientation to what is taught.



Extension Lectures & Seminars

Eminent Law Scholars and dignitaries are regularly invited to deliver Extension Lectures on the current issues and issues related to the subject to update the knowledge of the subject of the students and faculty.

Seminars on the current topics are organized by the College from time to time. Students are pursued to participate and present papers.

For this purpose, a well equipped Seminar aided by state-of the art equipment is in College having seating capacity of 100 persons.

Term Paper Presentation and field visit report : At the end of First, Second & Fourth Semester, the students have to prepare term report to be submitted within one week from the commencement of next semester and at the end of third & fifth semester the student have to go training for three weeks with a Law/Industrial/Business or Service Organization. Each student has to submit their training and field visit report within one week from the commencement of next Semester.

Dissertation : The students have to submit the dissertation at the end of Six Semester. Dissertation will be on the topic to be assigned by the concerned faculty.

Programme Administration (Suggested Guidelines)

Evaluation

- | Each paper will carry 100 marks of which minimum of 30% marks should be for internal assessment and remaining percentage of marks be for written examination. The duration of written examination for each paper shall be three hours.
- | The internal assessment marks shall be based on factors such as : Participation in seminars, case discussions and group work activities.
Class tests, quizzes, individual and group oral presentations.
Submission of written assignments, term papers and viva-voce.
Class-room participation and attendance
- | There will be one mid term class test which will carry 20 marks. If any candidate does not appear in any of the mid term tests on valid grounds, he may appear in the defaulter test by depositing a fee of Rs. 150/- per course.
- | The course for the mid term test will be first two units but the defaulter test coverage will be the entire course.
- | Home Assignment will carry 05 marks while individual and group presentation and attendance will carry 05 marks.
- | The scheme of evaluation of project studies shall be as follows:
- | A project report based on the summer training will have to be submitted within two weeks from the commencement of fifth semester.
- | The written part for each of project studies shall account for 70% of marks and the viva voce to be conducted by a duly constituted examination board for the remaining 30% of marks.
- | Promotion and Re-examination
As per Existing rules of the University for Semester Scheme and M.B.A.
- | Attendance
No candidate shall be considered to have pursued a regular course of study unless he/she is certified by the Dean of the Faculty to have attended the 75% of the total number of classroom sessions conducted in each semester during his/her course of study. Any student not complying with this requirement will not be allowed to appear in the semester examination.
A Student not allowed to appear in the preceding semester examination due to shortage of attendance, may appear in the papers of the proceeding semester along with the papers of current semester after making up the attendance shortfall. Remedial classes, however, will not be arranged by the Faculty for the purpose.
