"Fifty percent of the total seats of a particular discipline of study shall be reserved for residents of Jharkhand State or those who have passed the qualifying examination from the institutions located in Jharkhand State and to the wards of the Employees of the Central/State Government/University/Public Undertaking/Corporations/Boards/Academies, etc. working in Jharkhand State. Reservation policy in this regard shall be applicable for admission against these seats."
