## NOTIFICATION Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT- 2021)

Online Applications are invited for Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT-2021) for admission to the Ph.D. Course. Interested and eligible applicants can fill up the online application form through the University Website: <a href="https://www.ppup.ac.in">www.ppup.ac.in</a> from 05.03.2021 to 20.03.2021 (With Late Fine up to 25.03.2021).

Date of Entrance Test- 11.04.2021 (Sunday)

### 1. Criteria for appearing in the Ph.D. Admission test PAT-2021 are as follows: -

- A. Candidate seeking admission to the Ph.D. Programme should have a Master's Degree with at least 55% Marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the subject/in allied subject from recognized university.
- B. A relaxation of 5% of marks i.e. from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/BC/EBC/Differently-abled categories of candidates.
- C. A candidates shall be permitted to pursue research for the Ph.D degree in the subject in which he/she holds master degree/ in an allied subject from a recognized University. (Applicants from the allied subject will be awarded Ph.D. Degree in the main subject only)

Note:- Appearing candidate are not eligible for Ph.D Admission Test (PAT-2021)

## 2. Exemption from the written test of Ph.D Admission Test (PAT-2021): -

- A. Candidate who have passed <u>NET/JRF/</u> or have secured grants for research such as fellowship/scholarships offered by <u>DBT/ICMR/ICAR/DST/CSSIR/ICHR/ICPR</u> etc. will be exempted from Ph.D. Admission Test.
- B. Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor who have been appointed on substantive post in the UGC Pay scale in the teaching Department of the University or Constituent Colleges of this University, who have completed their probation successfully, with an experience of at least of two years of uninterrupted service would be exempted from the test. Teachers appointed in Self-Finance Courses and teachers belonging to those colleges running on self-finance basis will not be exempted from the test.
- C. Non-teaching employees of this university, who are holding substantive appointment for more than five years and have secured at least 55% marks in Master's Degree in the subject concerned and have published at least two research papers in any reputed referred journals or journals identified by the UGC would also be exempted from the test.

- Note 1: The Candidates who have applied earlier for PAT-2020 need not apply again.
- Note 2: Candidate of the exempted categories will have to appear directly before the interview board as per schedule along with candidates who have qualified PAT-2021.
- Note 3: Candidates who are exempted from the written test of Ph.D Admission Test PAT-2021 have to submit their application online with the payment of the required fee.

#### 3. How to Apply: -

Candidates are required to visit University Website <a href="www.ppup.ac.in">www.ppup.ac.in</a> and follow the PAT-2021 link available on the main page of the website to fill up the admission application form. Duly filled up and completed forms can be submitted online along with necessary supporting documents and requisite Test Fee from 07.03.2021 to 20.03.2021 without late fine and upto 25.03.2021 with late fine. Application Form incomplete in any respect will be rejected.

#### 4. Entrance Test Fee: -

A. General Category : Rs. 1500
B. Reserve Categories (SC/ST/EBC/BC/Divyang/Women) : Rs. 1000
C. Late Fine : Rs. 500

Mode of Payment of Test Fee: -

Candidates are required to make Online Payment (Non-refundable) through the payment Gateway displayed in course of filling up the online application form.

#### 5. Pattern of Test: -

Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT-2021) will consist of two papers of 100 marks each.

Paper-I: Shall consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions on qualitative teaching and research aptitude.

Paper-II: Shall also consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions from the Core Course/Paper-01 to Core Course/Paper-14 of the PG Subject/ Programme concerned.

Test of both the papers will be held in a single sitting of two hours and Thirty minutes. Question Booklet along with OMR Sheet of Paper-I will be given to the examinees on 11.00 AM. On completion of one hour and fifteen minutes (i.e. at 12.15 PM) candidates will be required to submit their OMR Sheet of Paper-I. After that, Question Booklet of Paper-II will be issued to them at 12:30 P.M. They will have to submit the OMR Sheet of Paper-II on completion of another one hour and fifteen minutes (i.e. at 01.45 PM).

Note: - There is no negative marking in any of the papers.
