

- ❑ Optional/Specialisation papers (4 papers of 4 credits each)
- Specialization papers will be offered in one or more groups of the specialization. Each group of specialization shall consist of several papers from which the students can choose the number required. Initially, the following specializations shall be offered:
 - Criminal Law and Criminal Justice
 - Police Studies
 - Corporate Governance and Taxation
 - IPR and Commercial Laws
 - Law and Medicine
 - Constitutional & Administrative Laws

Note: *The University may at its discretion alter the scheme and structure of specialization depending on availability of resources and other factors in the interest of the efficient conduct of the programme.*

EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION SCHEME

- There shall be End Semester Examination preferably in the Month of December/June or as may be notified by the University for the First Semester and the Second Semester.
- The examination may be open/closed book depending upon the particular requirement of any course.
- The performance of the candidates shall be evaluated on a six point scale with the corresponding Grade Values.
- The marks secured by the students shall be converted to the Grades.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab (RGNUL) has been established by the State Legislature of Punjab by passing the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law Punjab Act, 2006 (Punjab Act No. 12 of 2006). RGNUL campus is situated at Sidhuwal, Bhadson Road, Patiala (Punjab) which is about 70 km from Chandigarh. It is well connected by Air, Rail and Road. The University acquired approval of the Bar Council of India (BCI) in August 2006. The University got registered with the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi under Section 2(f) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and also got recognition under Section 12-B of the UGC Act. The RGNUL is a regular member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi and several other prestigious National and International institutions / organizations. **The RGNUL is the first National Law**

University which has been awarded 'A' Grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) after rigorous assessment based on various quality parameters. RGNUL has also been accorded Graded Autonomy under the UGC (Categorisation of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy) Regulations, 2018. RGNUL received a major boost for its performance by being placed in the top 10 Law universities in the NIRF rankings in 2018-19 and 2019-20. In Swachh Campus Rankings 2019 RGNUL has been adjudged at First Rank (Cleanest) in the Country among Government Residential Universities by MHRD.

The University is located at its permanent campus at Sidhuwal, Bhadson Road, Patiala in an area of 50 Acres. The *state-of-the-art* Campus has an Administrative Block, Academic Block, spacious Library Building, Auditorium, Sports Complex, Boys and Girls Hostels, Guest House, University Health Centre, Residences for the faculty and non-teaching employees of the University, Sports Complex, RGNUL Legal Aid Clinic and a facility area for students. All RGNUL Boys and Girls students are residing at the campus facilitated with modern amenities including air conditioned rooms.

LL.M. (EXECUTIVE) PROGRAMME



Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law

GENERAL

- The LL.M (Executive) programme shall be a course equivalent to a Post Graduate Diploma for the Executives/professionals. This programme is designed to enhance legal knowledge, with a focus on specific areas of interest.
- The medium of instructions and examination in the LL.M. (Executive) programme shall be English.
- The course shall be divided into two Semesters, Part -I and Part –II, in one Academic Year.
- Both the semesters shall consist of six months and their date of commencement will be notified by the university separately.

Note: *LL.M (Executive) programme shall not qualify a candidate for academic (and other) jobs that require LL.M as a minimum qualification. It shall also not qualify a candidate to appear for the UGC's National Eligibility Test or similar tests.*

ELIGIBILITY

- A graduate of any discipline, from any university, recognised by RGNUL, with a minimum of 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST candidates) in the aggregate of all years of the respective course and preferably has professional experience of at least

three years shall be eligible to enroll for the programme.

- The LL.M. (Executive) Programme will be conducted through blended learning mode.
- The students currently enrolled in the LL.M., Ph.D. or any other programme at RGNUL shall not be eligible to apply for the LL.M. (Executive) programme.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The admission shall be on merit basis. The percentage secured by the candidates in their graduation shall be considered for the merit list.
- Applications for the programme will be invited every year well before the start of the academic session. The schedule of commencement of the programme will be notified by the University.

INTAKE AND RESERVATION

- The total number of seats for the LL.M. (Executive) programme shall be 150. However, the University reserves the right to alter the number of seats for the programme in a given academic year without prior notice.
- 15% of the seats shall be reserved for individuals from the Scheduled Castes, 7.5% for individuals from the Scheduled Tribes, and 5% for persons with disabilities.

FEE

- The composite fees for the programme for Indian Nationals shall be Rs. 1,25,000 [One Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only]. Which is payable into two installments of Rs. 75,000/- and 50,000/- before commencement of semester respectively.
- For foreign nationals, the amount shall be USD 3500 [Three Thousand Five Hundred only].
- Fees shall be charged separately for re-registration, repeat exams etc.

ATTENDANCE

- Attendance in the contact classes is an important component of the programme, and is mandatory. Students shall attend the scheduled contact classes. In no event shall a student be absent for more than 30% of the contact classes held in the subject in a semester.
- Every student shall secure a minimum of 70% of attendance in every course to be eligible to appear for the end semester examination.

CURRICULUM

The programme shall consist of 24 credits in total with the following components:

 - ◆ Basic Introduction to Law and Legal System
 - ◆ Constitutional Law: An Introduction
