

The fee is non refundable; bank or payment gateway service charges must be borne by the applicant.

**Essential Qualifications:** The candidates who have scored minimum of 50% marks in aggregate in 10+2 with Mathematics or Business Statistics or Business Mathematics as one of the subject from a recognized School/College.
