SDMCET is an Autonomous Institution under VTU Belagavi, established in the year 1979 with just 03 branches and an intake of 90 students. Today, it has 07 UG programs, 06 M.Tech. programs and a MBA program with 3200 students on roll. It has total faculty strength of 175 and 261 supporting staff. All the 11 departments have been recognized as Research Centers for offering Ph.D. programs under VTU.

RECOGNITION:

The University Grants Commission, New Delhi granted Extension of Autonomous Status till 2019-20. Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi, granted Institutional Autonomy since 2016. Accordingly PG programs are also run under autonomy mode.

NBA ACCREDITATION:

- Three UG programs viz. Mechanical Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering and Chemical Engineering programs have been accredited for 3 years (June 2018 to June 2021).
- Four UG programs viz. Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering and Information Science & Engineering have cleared the pre-qualifier stage under Tier-I and Self Assessment Reports (SAR) have been submitted. NBA team is likely to visit our campus in August / September 2019.
