## UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

The eligibility criteria for all the courses taught in the college is as per the norms and curricula of the University of Rajasthan. These are amended from time to time as per the University of Rajasthan notifications.

### B.Sc. Pt.-I (Bachelor of Science)

#### Eligibility:

Candidate must have passed 10+2 examination in Science with 48% aggregate marks (Minimum pass marks acceptable only for SC/ST and OBC students).

Candidate must have passed 10+2 examination in any discipline with 45% aggregate marks (Minimum pass marks acceptable only for SC/ST and OBC students).

#### Optional Subjects:

#### B.A. Pt.-I (Bachelor of Arts)

### Eligibility:

Candidate must have passed 10+2 examination in any discipline with 45% aggregate marks (Minimum pass marks acceptable only for SC/ST and OBC students).

1. General Hindi 3. Elementary Computer Applications

4. Environmental Studies 2. General English

### Optional Subjects:

1. Economics 2. English Literature 3. Hindi Literature 4. History 5. Home Science 6. Political Science 7. Psychology 8. Public Administration 9. Sociology

# POST GRADUATE COURSES

# M.Sc. Prev. (Chemistry)

#### Eligibility:

Students are eligible to seek admission in M.Sc. if they have a B.Sc. Degree (Pass Course or Hons.) under the 10+2+3 scheme with Chemistry as one of the subjects.

Candidates should have scored minimum 55% marks in aggregate at 8.5c. level (36% marks in aggregate for SC/ST/ Non-Creamy layer OBC/SBC candidates).

## M.Com. Prev. (E.A.F.M.)

#### Eligibility:

Students are eligible to seek admission in M.Com. if they have secured at least 48% marks in aggregate with 55% in E.A.F.M. in B.Com,

# M.Com. Prev. (A.B.S.T.)

#### Eligibility:

Students are eligible to seek admission in this course if they have secured at least 48% marks in aggregate with 55% in A.B.S.T. in B.Com.

# M.A. Prev. (Public Administration)

Students are eligible to seek admission in M.A. if they have secured at least 48% marks in aggregate with 55% in Public Administration in B.A.

Candidates who have not studied the subject at graduation level, will be considered only if the aggregate percentage of marks obtained by them is equal to the marks obtained by the last candidate admitted in the course.

Candidates from any other Board or University outside the State of Rajasthan are eligible for admission only if they have secured minimum 60% marks in aggregate in class XII or at the Graduation level (Last Qualifying Exam).



# PROFESSIONAL COURSES

## BCA (Bachelor of Computer Application)

The BCA Programme is a popular course in the field of Information Technology (TT) as it opens up a number of career opportunities for the students.

#### Course Structure

The BCA programme is a 3-year course. Each year consists of six theory papers and four practical papers. The papers will be as per the syllabus of the University of Rajasthan.

### Eligibility:

A candidate must have passed 10+2 examination (Arts / Science / Commerce) or equivalent, with minimum 48% marks in aggregate (minimum pass marks acceptable only for SC/ST/08C/SBC candidates) without any approximations.

### BBA (Bachelor of Buisness Administration)

BBA programme offers a new vision for business education. Students will graduate with practical knowledge and skills that will help them set the highest possible standards at the workplace.

#### Course Structure

The 3-year course consists of six papers each year. The papers will be as per the syllabus of the University of Rajasthan.

#### Eligibility:

Students of all faculties (Science, Commerce and Arts) are eligible for admission in BBA if they have secured at least 48% marks in aggregate in 10+2 examination or equivalent.

# FEE REGULATIONS

- Every student seeking admission in the college shall have to deposit the requisite fee by the last date. In case the fee is not deposited by the due date, admission will be considered null and yold.
- At the time of admission, the entire annual fee, caution money and other fees have to be deposited in a single installment. It is mandatory to deposit the fee for the whole session even if a student seeks admission mid-session.
- Information about the University Examination fee will be put up on the college notice board

After January, the caution money will not be refunded and instead be transferred to the collegestudents' fund.
- Please inform the college office if you leave the college midsession.
- Parents/Guardians will be solely responsible for all the fees and dues, if any.
- Regular students seeking admission in Part-II and III, are required to fill re-admission forms within 15 days from the date of declaration of their result, otherwise they will have to pay the late fee prescribed by the college.

### Admission Know-How

Admission is on the basis of merit of marks secured in Class XII or graduation examination. Weightage is given as per state government norms. As the number of seats is limited, minimum eligibility does not guarantee admission. Admission Guidelines

#### LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Every student will be provided with an identity curn library card at the beginning of the session which will entitle her to get two books issued at a time.
- · Entry in the library will be strictly through the card
- The card is non-transferable. In case the card is lost, a written application has to be given
  to the librarian and a new card will be issued after a deposit of ₹100/-
- Books are generally issued for one week, but if the student wants to re-issue the same book, it will be issued only if no other student has requested the same book
- A fine of ₹ 5/- per day will be imposed if the books are not returned by the scheduled date
  of submission
- Do not damage the books, magazines or periodicals. In case of loss or damage to any book, the student will either have to reimburse a new copy or pay the cost of the book damaged or lost



# CAMPUS CODE | Conduct Control


