## LIBRARY

The general Library is housed in a spacious magnificent building and it is very user friendly. There are more than 1,20,000 books and 150 Journals. There is also a U.G.C. Book Bank in addition, each Post-Graduate and Under-Graduate Department maintains a separate department library with an excellent collection of standard text books, and leading Journals with back volumes.



## COMPUTER FACILITIES

The college has a well-equipped computer centre and a comprehensive collection of softwares for the students to gain better practical exposure. The computer centre is kept open from morning 8.30 to evening 7.30 for the students to learn the advanced concepts in IT field. Internet facilities with 50 mbps leased line are available 24 hours for the utilisation of staff members and students. The campus is completely WiFi enabled.

## EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

## HOSTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

All the students who do not reside with their parents or guardians should stay in the hostel. The application form can be obtained from the Hostel Office. Every applicant must submit two passport size photos along with the application form.

The Hostel Mess is being run under the dividing system. Both Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian meals are served separately. The Deposit amount is adjusted against the mess bills for the last two months of the academic year and the balance, if any, will be refunded through the bank. Hostel rules and regulations must be strictly followed. Any violation of Hostel rules will lead to dismissal from the Hostel. Any grievance must be communicated to the Hostel Authorities.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The admission to the college is not a guarantee for an automatic pass. All the students have to strive hard for achieving academic excellence making the maximum use of available facilities.

The students will be removed from the rolls of the college if their attendance / conduct is not good and if they fail in all the papers of Summative Examinations in each semester.

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application Form for Under-Graduate and Diploma Courses can be obtained from the College Office on payment of ₹ 50/- in person or ₹ 75/- by electronic Money Order addressed to the Principal. The candidate should state the course for which the admission is desired.

Application Form for P.G. Courses can be obtained from the College Office on payment of ₹ 60/- in person or ₹ 85/- by electronic Money Order and for M.Phil. Courses ₹ 60/- in person or ₹ 85/- by electronic Money Order addressed to the Principal.

#### **Cheques and Postal Orders will not be accepted.**

The application form should be filled in correctly by the candidate in his/her own hand writing and submitted to the Principal along with Photo copies of the Transfer Certificate, Mark Sheet, Community Certificate and Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution where the applicant last studied and two self-addressed envelopes of 28 x 12.5 cm. in size affixed with postage stamp for the value of ₹. 5/-

The Mark Certificates of the admitted candidates are subject to verification by the Director of Government Examination and if any Mark Certificate is found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancellation. Besides, strict penal action also will be taken.

PG admission will be made on the basis of marks obtained upto Fifth semester at the UG Level.

The interview card will be sent to each candidate considered for selection by post. The recipient of the interview card has to appear for an interview with his / her Parent in time. The selected candidate will be admitted to the course to which he / she is found suitable. On admission, he / she has to pay the required fees and produce the following certificates in original.

1. Mark Sheet
2. Transfer Certificate
3. Conduct Certificate
4. Attendance Certificate from the institution where he / she last Studied.
5. Community Certificate (Photo copy for the SC / ST / DNC / MBC / BC Candidates).
6. Ration Card (or) Aadhaar Card (Photo Copies)
7. Candidate Bank A/c Pass Book Front Page (Photo Copies)

Under any circumstances, the certificates submitted to the college at the time of admission will not be returned during the course of study. Hence the candidates are advised to retain adequate number of photo copies of the same with attestation before submitting the originals to the college.

The applicants who have passed the examinations of other Universities or Bodies should produce at the time of admission the following certificates in original.

- a) Transfer Certificate
- b) Mark Sheet
- c) Provisional Certificate
- d) Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Madurai Kamaraj University.
- e) Migration Certificate.

Six seats in Under-Graduate Courses are reserved for the children of Ex-serviceman of Tamilnadu origin. They should produce their dependency certificate at the time of admission.

### FEES

Fees will be collected as per Government recommendations. For full details, please refer to the College Notice Board.

There will be **NO REFUND OF FEES** under any circumstance once it is paid.

### CAUTION DEPOSIT

The caution deposit paid at the time of admission is for the entire course of study. The deposit is subject to adjustment towards penalties.

### UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE FEES

The candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examinations (+2) from State Board of Higher Secondary Examinations, Government of Tamilnadu should remit ₹ 300/- (₹ 250/- for Recognition and ₹ 50/- for University Entrance Fee.)

The candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations in other Universities / Bodies within India should remit ₹ 315/- (Recognition fee, University Entrance fee ₹ 300/- and ₹ 15/- for cost application).

### FEE CONCESSION UNDER THE TAMILNADU EDUCATIONAL RULES

The students belonging to SC / ST, including the converts are eligible for the award of full fee concession against the production of Community Certificate from the Deputy Tahsildar. The students benefitted under the TNER must put in the minimum attendance of 90 percent.
