2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	Teaching & Learning: When the lockdown was imposed in March 2020, the syllabus to the extent of 65-70% was completed and it was challenge for the faculty to complete 30-35% syllabus.
	Within the rubric of statutory guidelines; a plethora of Technology based initiatives were adopted by the Institute to minimize Academic loss and ensure academic progression of learners. Unhindered curricular transaction was targeted with capacity building initiatives for all Teachers and students to effectively use various online teaching-learning platforms like ZOOM, Microsoft Teams, Cisco Webex etc.
	Appropriate hand holding mechanisms were identified for smooth transition from onsite to online mode of curricular delivery, finally OTL settled on Google G Suite. Online training sessions were organized for faculty members and students for ensuring effective usage. The course material was shared with students through G-classroom in the form of course ppts, recorded online lectures of faculty of around 45-50 hrs per course and NPTEL videos.
	Student engagement and mentoring: The classes engagement was monitored and students attending classes was ensured. The assignments and practice papers were delivered to students through email and WhatsApp. The quizzes were conducted by teachers, solved assignments submissions through G-Suite and Moodle platform. The practical laboratory sessions were conducted using Simulation software's, Virtual LABS of IIT and recorded sessions by respective faculty members. Students were encouraged to use NPTEL/SWAYAM Videos and Certification, MOOC courses, register for Online & offline internship. Coursera has offered free online course learning & certification through institutional membership login credentials. Discipline specific virtual industry tours were also organized.
	Assessment and feedback: Learning was ensured by Continuous objective assessments on Google forms, assignments and discussion forums. The assessment was done using digital platforms, quizzes through Google quiz, evaluation of practical records, viva-voce, seminar delivery, project demonstrations were carried out in online mode. Review and monitoring was done at through periodic student feedback, Student Interactions, Academic appraisal program and TL audits were analyzed for taking corrective measures.
	The mid semester and end semester examination were conducted in online mode. The final examination of Eighth semester was conducted adhering to the guidelines of UGC and RTM Nagpur university based on MCQ format during October-2020. The First, Second and Third year students were promoted to higher classes and their regular classes of ODD-semester 2020-21 started in July-2020 through online mode using Google classroom and Google meet platform.
	Student Placements : Students were addressed by T&P Department about the impact of lockdown and change in hiring pattern by conducting webinars on Webex, Zoom, Google Meet etc Whatsapp group of Placement Coordinators (Faculty & Students) with class wise groups were formed to circulate the details about placement activities.
	Online CRT, Online Domain Classes, Online Aptitude Test & Mock Interview was conducted with the help of TCS to get familiar with online recruitment process. For current batch 2020-21, many recruiters have conducted online recruitment process starting from PPT to Final Interview & good numbers of students were recruited, by Accenture, Capgemini, TCS, Cognizant, Tata Advanced Systems Ltd., e-infoChips etc.
